Meanwhile King Herod takes extreme measures to protect his throne from a rival king.

Mary's Choice	10	6	The devil tries to convince Mary that giving birth to the savior is a bad idea while David, Ruth and Rahab encourage her to accept God's plan for her life.
Promised Children, Promised Child	9-22+	35	The black sheep in the genealogy of Jesus; 19 scenes; (includes song & optional video suggestions)
Angels, shepherds & God News	3	4	Humorous look at what a strange way the second most important event in human history took place
The Birth of Jesus Foretold RT	8+	11 minutes	5 scenes; readings from the gospels of Matthew and Luke
The Well	17	22	The nativity story in dramatic format for mature casts. Includes the possible reactions by those around to Mary's claim to be carrying the Son of God. Young women in Nazareth respond to her pregnancy with near vicious gossip and speculation while her parents are concerned and bewildered. Only Joseph and Elizabeth truly believe her claims to have seen an angel. The

			final scene occurs at a well in Samaria with Jesus talking to a woman who came to draw water.

Elizabeth & Zechariah	2	6	The elderly couple decides to leave civilization and bring John up in the desert because of Herod's violent jealousy over a rival king
Light of the World	9	6	The story of God's redeeming plan told in allegory. Deceived by Darkman, the princess loses her position and freedom. The prince comes to save her, losing his life, but she chooses to remain in darkness. The audience joins their

			lights with the cast to reach her.
