Daniel requested **vegetables** to eat and water to drink.

Daniel understood visions and dreams of every kind and said "May the name of God be praised forever and ever, for wisdom and power belong to Him. He changes the times and seasons; He removes kings and establishes kings. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding"?

Chaldeans Babylonian name for wise men, diviner-priests, mediums, sorcerers, and astrologers

Arioch the commander of the king's guard who planned to execute the wise men

A **stone** broke off without a hand touching it, struck the statue on its feet of iron and fired clay, and crushed them.

The God of heaven gave Nebuchadnezzar sovereignty, power, **strength**, and glory.

The God of heaven will set up a **kingdom** that will never be destroyed, At Daniel's request, the king appointed Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego to manage the province of **Babylon**.

At the sound of the horn, **flute**, zither, lyre, harp, drum, and every kind of music, people were to fall down and worship the gold statue or be It looked like four men were walking in the **furnace** of blazing fire.

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego violated the king's command and risked their **lives** rather than serve or worship any god except their own God.

Nebuchadnezzar saw an observer, a holy one, coming down from heaven and saying, 'Cut down the **tree** and destroy it, but leave the stump with its roots in the ground

Daniel recommended that Nebuchadnezzar separate "yourself from your sins by doing what is right, and from your injustices by showing mercy to the **needy**."

Nebuchadnezzar's hair grew like eagles' feathers and his nails like birds' claws.

King Belshazzar saw the **fingers** of a man's hand begin writing on the plaster of the king's palace wall next to the lampstand.

The **queen** recommended Daniel interpret what was written on the wall **Belshazzar**, have not humbled your heart, even though you knew all this. Instead, you have exalted yourself against the Lord of heaven by bringing the vessels from the temple for his party.

God holds our life-breath in His **hand** and controls the whole course of our lives

Daniel was thrown into the **lions'** den.

Darius wrote that people must tremble in fear before the God of Daniel because "He is the living God, and He endures forever; He rescues and delivers; He performs signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth"
