

Two Pieces

CHARACTERS: 2 children

PROPS: A piece of candy

COSTUMES: Street clothes

SETTING: None specified

At rise, 2 young children sitting. If played by adults the characters should swing their feet pigeon toed and have other mannerisms of small children. Items discussed can be adjusted to suit the genders of the characters.

A: If you had two ponies, would you give me one?

B: Sure. If I had two ponies, I'd give you one.

A: *(Tickled with the answer)* You're my bestest friend. *(Pause)* If you had two Spiderman comics, would you give me one?

B: Sure. If I had two Spiderman comics I'd give you one.

A: You just are my bestest friend. You're the best friend I've got. *(Pause for thinking)* If you had two Reece's Pieces sundaes with extra chocolate would you give me one?

B: Sure. If I had two Reece's Pieces sundaes, I'd give you one.

A: I couldn't have a better friend than you in the whole wide world. *(Pause)*. If you had two pieces of candy, would you give me one?

B: No

A: *(Somewhat hurt and puzzled)* Why not?

B: *(Pulling a piece of candy out of pocket)* Because I HAVE 2 pieces of candy.
