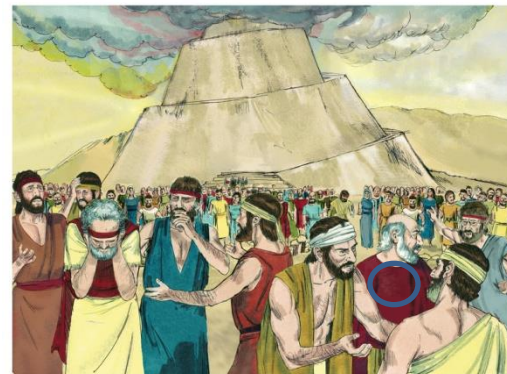
Communication disadvantages

Hearing impaired	Must wear head phones, ear plugs or use some other hearing impairing device
Articulation disorder	May only speak with 6 regular sized marshmallows in mouth OR when holding tongue between thumb and one finger
Blind	Wears blindfold – is the only person(s) who can touch locks
Pig Latin	Must speak only pig Latin (ig-Pay atin-lay)
Yoda language speaker	Any verb(s) in a sentence must come at the end of the sentence
Whisperer	Can only whisper to communicate
Sign language	May only communicate using hands or whole body; may NOT write
Lip syncher	May only articulate words without speaking or signing therefore forcing others to lip read. May not write or use hands at all; must wear mittens duct taped together
Writer	May communicate using writing only

SPECIAL RULES: Only a blind person may touch the locks

A radio set between stations to full blast static must be played at all times

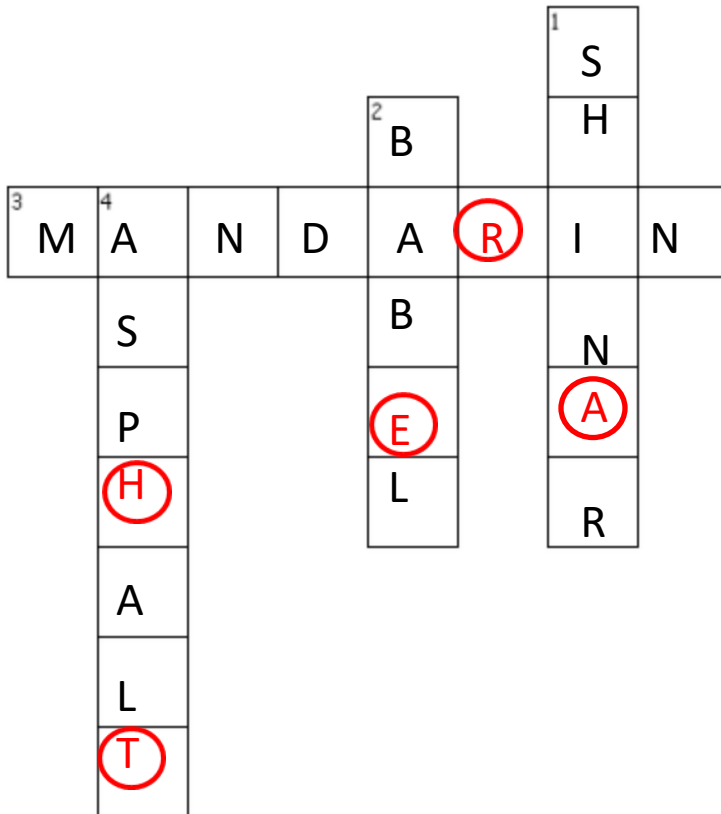
